The enclosed report provides an overview of Resource Recovery Program activity from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024.

Overall, the Resource Recovery Program collected \$1,374,502.33 in revenue and paid \$1,299,996.50 in expenses.


Revenue collected by each PGU is placed in an individual recycling surcharge account, and all financial activity is recorded in EDEN. Individual financial reports are available upon request throughout the year. A yearly summary is included at the end of this report.



RESOURCE RECOVERY PROGRAM



Curbside (blue) and drop-site (green)

shown on the graph to the left is monthly totals of single stream recycling by residential access (in tons).

Together in 2024, we collected a total of:

3,197,220 lbs.



drop-sites

544,700 pounds

Six PGUs operate drop-site recycling locations. Collectively, these sites recycle an average of 22.69 tons of recycling each month. Drop-sites benefit residents by providing a convenient central collection location to recycle materials.



curbside

2,435,940 pounds

Fourteen PGUs offer curbside recycling services to residents. These PGUs collect an average of 110.52 tons of single-stream recycling each month. Curbside recycling provides residents with a convenient scheduled pick-up of recyclables.



We collected 59,863 pounds in 2024:




At 2 regional recycling depot sites, there were 1,154 visits:
