RULES OF ORGANIZATION—DIVISION OF QUESTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby replaces the current language within the Division of Question section of the Board Rules of Organization and Procedure to read as follows:

DIVISION OF QUESTION: If the question being discussed contains two or more points, each of which is capable of standing as a complete proposition if the others are removed, any BOC member may make a motion to divide the question. Once the motion to divide a question is made, seconded, the BOC must vote on whether to divide the question without debate. If the motion passes, the BOC must then vote on each separate part as if each were a separate motion. Examples of form: "I move to divide the question into 2 parts as follows ..." or "I move to divide the question so as to consider separately the part about ..."
